



INFRASTRUCTURE SPOTLIGHT

Chief Tonasket Park - South Access

Discussions are underway with Genesee and Wyoming Railroad to explore the feasibility of a new south access at Chief Tonasket Park. Current conversations focus on signage requirements, closure considerations, and preliminary conceptual designs with cost estimates.

At this stage, no traffic or railroad studies have been completed, and there is not yet a formal agreement with Genesee and Wyoming. However, funding has been successfully leveraged to support the study, reporting, and preliminary design phases.

Next steps include submitting a grade crossing application with detailed designs and location information if access proves feasible. Once an agreement is reached, coordination will begin with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to move the project forward.
